The Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2016 was another exciting and successful year for the Tuscola Community Foundation. Distributions and expenses increased to over \$90,000, indicating a very active year of support for community events and activities. The largest single distribution was for the Imagination Station Playground at Erving Park, a collaborative effort between TCF, Tuscola Rotary, and the City of Tuscola.

The SAM Food Pantry, the Nunn Memorial Scout Building, and programs for Douglas County Seniors are some of the many programs that have benefitted from your continued support.

Scholarships to Tuscola High School graduates are also an important part of TCF's mission. In this fiscal year, scholarship awards increased to \$4,500, thanks in part to the establishment of the Miss Tuscola Scholarship fund within TCF. Additionally, TCF will be administering the recently established Rutan Family Memorial Scholarship to TCHS graduating seniors. Dale Rutan is a member of the TCHS Class of 1955, and we are honored that he and his family chose to support his hometown through the Tuscola Community Foundation.

The new fiscal year is already well underway, and I hope to see many of you at our annual meeting on October 26, 2016. Plans are also shaping up for the Annual Reception in the spring of 2017, and we will get the word out as soon as those plans are finalized.
